Registration Process:

- 1 The first step toward registering is to decide which charterhip route you want to pursue based upon your discipline, role and career aspirations.
- 2 Following this you will need to register with your chosen institute and send confirmation and invoice to peopleandskills@energus.co.uk. (Info on how to apply can be found here: <https://www.theiet.org/membership/become-a-member/>)
- 3 On the People and Skills Programme Management System you need to log which institute you have registered with and provide your membership number.
- 4 To register onto the accredited Nuclear Graduates IET scheme, you need to go into the career manager area on the IET website <https://www.theiet.org/career/professional-development/career-manager/> (via the career and learning tab).
- 5 Following this, you will need to click on the 'Schemes and Apprenticeships' tab and then 'Enrol on IET Accredited Scheme'. Once here, you will need to enter scheme number '1946' and follow the instructions.
