Registration Process:

- 1 The first step toward registering is to decide which chartership route you want to pursue based upon your discipline, role and career aspirations.
- 2 Following this you will need to register with your chosen institute and send confirmation and invoice to peopleandskills@energus.co.uk. (Info on how to apply can be found here: <https://www.imeche.org/membership-registration/become-a-member>)
- 3 On the People and Skills Programme Management System you need to log which institute you have registered with and provide your membership number.
- 4 Following this you will be issued with the registration form that will need to be returned to the P&S team to enable you to be registered on the Nuclear Graduates IMechE MPDS scheme, via the Career Developer tool.
- 5 This will need to be completed by yourself and your mentor and returned back to P&S team, who will then register you.
